Dear Parents,

Primary 4/5 have settled brilliantly into the new term. Below you will find some information about what the class will be learning over the next term.

Literacy

Spelling

During spelling lessons, pupils will work on a new sound or spelling pattern every 1-2 weeks. Each week pupils will use a range of spelling strategies, including active spelling games, to help memorise their words.

Reading and Writing

This term, we will be focussing on personal and reflective writing. Pupils will read and discuss texts written in the first person as well as trying to identify where writing could be made more exciting by using interesting vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation (VCOP).

Maths

P4/5 will be working on extending their knowledge in a range of numeracy areas. We will be focussing on;

- Place value, addition, subtraction and multiplication.
- Measure
- Data Handling
- Mental Maths

Emotional Check-in


Each morning we begin our day with an emotional check-in. This gives the pupils an opportunity to share their thoughts and feelings with the class and teacher.
